## Restaurant Orana in Adelaide takes top national award

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AN Adelaide restaurant has been named the best in Australia, beating more than 500 top eateries around the country.

Restaurant Orana, run by Jock Zonfrillo, took out the Restaurant of the Year in the *2019 Good Food Guide*. The awards were announced on Monday night in Melbourne.

Zonfrillo's tiny eatery, which seats just 24 people, was awarded "three hat" status, along with seven other eateries around the country.

Restaurant Orana has been a consistent award winner for its pioneering use of indigenous ingredients, or bush foods, in a fine dining context.

Chef Jock Zonfrillo took out the prestigious <u>Basque Culinary World Prize in July</u>, recognising chefs who reach a broader sphere of influence beyond the kitchen, playing a part in "transforming society through gastronomy".

Zonfrillo has visited hundreds of indigenous communities to research their use of native ingredients.

Restaurant Orana was the only South Australian restaurant to win three hats in the *Good Food Guide*, and scored 18/20 in its final analysis.

Two SA restaurants received "two hats": Hentley Farm and Magill Estate.

Thirteen SA restaurants received "one hat": they were Africola, Appellation, Bistro Blackwood, Botanic Gardens Restaurant, The Currant Shed, d'Arenberg Cube Restaurant, FermentAsian, Osteria Oggi, The Pot by Emma McCaskill, Press Food and Wine, Shobosho, Stone's Throw and The Summertown Aristologist.
